CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highways and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highways indicating their names:

Designated Name	Highway
"Lieutenant Michael J. Lutz Memorial Highway" 1	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 60, between County Road 97 and the boundary of Muskingum and Morgan Counties in Muskingum County.
"Deputy Sheriff Robert M. Tanner, Jr. Memorial Highway" ²	The northwesterly and southeasterly lanes of State Route 146, between Musselman Dr. and Shannon Valley Rd., in Muskingum County.

COMMENT

Lieutenant Michael J. Lutz, a member of the Muskingum County Sheriff's Department, was killed in the line of duty in 1994 after responding to a burglary. Deputy Sheriff Robert M. Tanner, Jr., also a member of the Department, was killed in the line of duty in 2002 after being flagged down by a driver.
