Detailed Analysis

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Judge Robert Duncan Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The eastbound lanes of I-70, between the intersections I-71 and the James Road exit, in Franklin County.
Other Information	Judge Robert Duncan was the first African-American elected to judicial office in Franklin County, Ohio, the first to serve on the Ohio Supreme Court, the first to win a seat in a statewide Ohio election, the first to serve on the U.S. Court of Military Appeals, and the first appointed to the federal bench in Ohio.
