## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"SGT Meredith L. Barnett Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route 550, between Barnett Ridge Road and Stone Quarry Road, in Washington County.
Other Information	SGT Meredith L. Barnett served in the U.S. Marine Corps during the Vietnam War. He was killed in action on November 6, 1970, while protecting a fellow Marine, and was posthumously awarded the Silver Star.
