SUMMARY

Requires a campaign committee, political action committee, legislative campaign fund, political party, or political contributing entity to include, with the form to be filed with the Secretary of State when appointing a campaign treasurer, a notarized signature of that treasurer acknowledging the appointment.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Campaign treasurer

The bill requires a campaign committee, political action committee, legislative campaign fund, political party, or political contributing entity to include, with the form to be filed with the Secretary of State when appointing a campaign treasurer, a notarized signature of that treasurer acknowledging the appointment. Under continuing law, a committee, fund, party, or entity must appoint a treasurer and file, on a form prescribed by the Secretary, a designation of that appointment before receiving a contribution or making an expenditure. The designation must include the full name and address of the treasurer and be filed with the Secretary of State or appropriate board of elections, as specified by law.¹
