DETAILED ANALYSIS

License Plate	Harrison Central Huskies license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by representatives of the Harrison Central Jr./Sr. High School, and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. ¹
Recipients	Available to all applicants.
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.
Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution	\$20 required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee. The Registrar must pay the contributions to the Harrison Central Jr./Sr. High School located in the municipal corporation of Cadiz. ²
Requirements for Issuance	1. Submission of an application; 2. Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and 3. Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.

Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. ³
