SUMMARY

- Appropriates \$20 million from GRF to the Ohio Housing Finance Agency to support homeless shelters and provide emergency rental assistance as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Declares an emergency.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Appropriation to support homeless shelters

The bill appropriates \$20 million from GRF in FY 2020 to the Ohio Housing Finance Agency (OHFA) to support homeless shelters in Ohio and provide necessary emergency rental assistance as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. The OHFA must develop rules to establish an emergency rental assistance program to support individuals affected by the COVID-19 pandemic and any orders from the Director of Health issued on March 9, 2020, and after.¹

Emergency clause

The bill is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and therefore goes into immediate effect.² Emergency laws require a two-thirds vote of the members of each house.³ However, the bill consists entirely of an appropriation for current expense, which under the Ohio Constitution, takes effect immediately and requires only a majority vote of the members of each house.⁴
