SUMMARY

- Delays the earliest date by which school districts, community schools, and STEM schools may be required to submit a new five-year projection of operational revenues and expenditures in fiscal year 2021 to December 31, 2020.
- Declares an emergency.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Five-year projections of operational revenues and expenditures

The bill delays the earliest date by which school districts, community schools, and science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) schools may be required to submit a new five-year projection of operational revenues and expenditures in fiscal year 2021 to December 31, 2020.¹ Continuing law requires the Department of Education and the Auditor of State to adopt rules requiring school districts, community schools, and STEM schools to submit a five-year projections, but they are prohibited from requiring districts and schools to submit a new five-year projection earlier than November 30 in any fiscal year.²

The bill also specifies that, if the projection is required to be used for any purpose, the most recent available projection must be used.³
