## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Deputy Sheriff Emil Kleinwaechter Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The portion of U.S. Route 50 running in an easterly and westerly direction between Newtown Road and Elm Road, in Hamilton County.
Other Information	Deputy Emil Kleinwaechter was killed in the line of duty on July 16, 1962. While responding to a traffic accident, he was struck by a motor vehicle travelling at a high rate of speed that crossed over the centerline. He served with the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office for 13 years.
