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Highlights

- The Ohio Department of Health, Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation Retail Compliance Unit, local health departments, and local law enforcement agencies may realize a decrease in inspection costs if fewer physical inspections of retailers occur as a result of the bill's provisions.

Detailed Analysis

Termination of certain health order provisions

The bill terminates the paragraph labeled "10. Cooperation." of the "Director's Order for Retail and Business Compliance for Facial Coverings throughout the State of Ohio," issued on November 13, 2020, which requires businesses do the following: (1) allow access to, and permit inspection of the public areas of their premises by representatives of the Ohio Department of Health (ODH), local health departments (LHDs) or districts, and law enforcement during all business hours, (2) provide any information regarding compliance with the order that is requested, and (3) cooperate fully in any inspection or investigation of compliance with the order. As a result, the bill may result in reduced inspection costs for ODH, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation Retail Compliance Unit, LHDs, and local law enforcement agencies if fewer physical inspections are conducted at retail locations. Any other potential impacts are difficult to predict. The bill also declares an emergency.
