Other Information	The bill states:
	 Former President Donald J. Trump was our 45th President of the United States and accomplished many great feats and addressed issues that have led our state and nation to unparalleled prosperity.
	 A record 3,154,834 Ohio voters cast their ballot to re-elect Donald J. Trump as President – an historic number of votes received for President in Ohio.
