This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_134_1302)
Diagnostic services	
Expands the age limit for free diagnostic services to determine if a resident has a medically handicapping condition from 21 to 26. This expansion is gradual, with the maximum age limit increasing by one year annually from 2022 to 2026. (R.C. 3701.023)	No provision.
Appropriation	
No provision.	Appropriates \$500,000 in each of fiscal years 2022 and 2023 from the General Revenue Fund to the Medically Handicapped Children line item.  (Sections 3, 4, and 5)
