## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Deputy Bill Brewer Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route 32, between the eastern and western border of Batavia Township in Clermont County
Other Information	On February 2, 2019, Clermont County Deputy Bill Brewer was shot and killed during a standoff with a gunman at a Pierce Township apartment complex.
