S.B. 195 134th General Assembly **Bill Analysis**

SUMMARY

- Specifies that the database of individuals registered, and personal information of registered individuals contained within the database, for the Vax-A-Million campaign is confidential and is not a public record under Ohio's Public Records Law.
- Declares an emergency, meaning that the bill takes effect immediately.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Vax-A-Million database information

The bill specifies that the database of individuals registered, and personal information of registered individuals contained within the database, for the Vax-A-Million campaign is confidential and is not a public record under Ohio's Public Records Law.¹

The bill defines "personal information" to include the name, electronic mail address, telephone number, street address, and vaccine location information of individuals who registered for the Vax-A-Million campaign, and includes the name, electronic mail address, and telephone number of a parent or guardian.

The bill also defines the "Vax-A-Million campaign" to be the campaign held in 2021 consisting of a series of statewide drawings to provide prizes to individuals who receive a COVID-19 vaccination.²
