## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Officer Wayne A. Leon Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of Lorain Avenue, between 65 <sup>th</sup> Street and West 30 <sup>th</sup> Street, within the municipal corporation of Cleveland
Other Information	Officer Wayne A. Leon was shot and killed in the line of duty on June 25, 2000, after he stopped to question a man who was suspected of being involved in a shooting that occurred the previous day. He served with the Cleveland Police Department for six years.
