### Highlights

- The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will incur costs of approximately \$1,400 to produce and install each set of signs for each designated memorial highway or bridge in the bill. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.

### Detailed Analysis

#### Memorial highway designation

Memorial Highway Designation

The table above summarizes details about the memorial highway designated by the bill, including the location and the entity responsible for installing the signs. The cost of producing and installing signs is approximately \$1,400. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will produce and install the signs for the highway designated by this bill.

#### “ALS Awareness” license plate

The bill changes the name of one of the organizations receiving contributions from the “ALS Awareness” license plate from “ALS Association Central & Southern Ohio Chapter” to “ALS United Ohio, Incorporated,” to reflect that organization’s name change. Upon the change, funds

that are currently on hold with the Registrar of Motor Vehicles will be released to that organization for the original intended purpose.
