SUMMARY

 Makes retired teachers who are reemployed in positions covered by the State Teachers Retirement System (STRS) eligible to seek election to the STRS Board as retired teacher members.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

State Teachers Retirement Board membership

The act makes teachers retired from the State Teachers Retirement System (STRS) (called "superannuates") who are reemployed in positions covered by STRS eligible to seek election to the STRS Board as retired teacher members.¹ Under former law, a reemployed superannuate could not seek election to the Board.²

The 11-member Board includes seven elected members under continuing law:

- Five members, known as contributing members, must be STRS members (superannuates and reemployed superannuates are not STRS members³).
- Two members, known as retired teacher members, must be superannuates.

A reemployed superannuate may seek election under the act as a retired teacher member. The act does not affect the terms of Board members serving on the act's effective date.⁴
