#### **SUMMARY**

- Requires the Director of Commerce, in consultation with the Director of Veterans Services, to create a veterans' benefits and services poster.
- Requires the Director of Commerce to provide an employer with a copy of the poster at the employer's request, and allows the employer to display it on the employer's premises.

#### **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

### Veterans' benefits and services poster

The bill directs the Director of Commerce, in consultation with the Director of Veterans Services, to create a veterans' benefits and services poster. The Director of Commerce must include information about the following topics in the poster:

- Department of Veterans Services' programs, contact information, and website;
- The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs veterans crisis hotline;
- Substance abuse and mental health treatment programs;
- Educational, workforce, and training resources;
- Tax benefits and exemptions;
- Availability of armed forces designation on Ohio driver's license or identification card;
- Unemployment benefits;
- Legal services;

 Availability of any other benefit or service for veterans that the Directors determine should be included.<sup>1</sup>

The bill requires the Director of Commerce to provide an employer with a copy of the poster free of charge at the employer's request. The bill permits an employer employing employees in Ohio to display a copy of the poster on the employer's premises in a conspicuous place that is frequented by the largest number of employees and to which all employees have access.<sup>2</sup>
