The bill has no direct fiscal effect on the state or political subdivisions. The bill prohibits any person or athlete agent from entering into a fee agreement or contract involving the use of a student-athlete's name, image, and likeness (NIL) that would remain in effect beyond the period for which the student-athlete is eligible to participate in intercollegiate athletics. It also prohibits an athlete agent from entering into an agent contract under which the agent represents an athlete in relation to contracts or legal matters regarding opportunities to earn compensation for use of the athlete's NIL if the agent contract remains in effect after the athlete's intercollegiate athletic eligibility ends.
