#### SUMMARY

 Allows Ohio residents who are 65 and older, instead of 66 and older, to qualify for discounted hunting and fishing licenses and permits.

### **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

#### Senior hunting and fishing licenses and permits

The bill expands the eligibility for an Ohio resident wishing to obtain any of the following discounted senior hunting or fishing licenses or permits at a discounted rate by triggering eligibility at age 65 instead of 66:

- 1. Hunting or fishing license, \$9.00;<sup>1</sup>
- 2. Deer permit or wild turkey permit, \$11.00;<sup>2</sup>
- 3. Fur taker permit, \$7.00;<sup>3</sup>
- 4. Three-year hunting or fishing license, \$26.00;
- 5. Five-year hunting or fishing license, \$43.34; or
- 6. Lifetime hunting or fishing license, \$81.00.4
