The bill has no direct fiscal effect on the state or its political subdivisions. It specifies that persons who are unlawfully present in the U.S. are not privileged from arrest and prohibits a public office or public official from taking or attempting to take certain actions related to the enforcement of federal immigration laws. The bill largely mirrors current federal requirements, but makes clear that the bill supersedes any conflicting rule, ordinance, resolution, policy, directive, or other conflicting action of a public office or public official, to the extent they exist.
