## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Freedom Parkway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of U.S. Route 36, between I-71 and South Galena Road, in Delaware County
Other Information	The Freedom Parkway is named for both the freedoms that are the foundational principles on which the U.S. was built and for the Underground Railroad, of which many Delaware County residents took part. These residents helped runaway slaves to be "conducted" through Ohio seeking freedom as they worked their way to safe areas in the north.
