## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"PFC John Wayne Richard Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 47 between McGreevey Road and Long Road in Darke County	
Other Information	PFC John Wayne Richard served in the U.S. Army in South Vietnam during the Vietnam War. He was killed in action while fighting communist forces on May 21, 1969.
