### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"PFC John Wayne Richard Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 47 between McGreevey Road and Long Road in Darke County
<b>Other Information</b>	PFC John Wayne Richard served in the U.S. Army in South Vietnam during the Vietnam War. He was killed in action while fighting communist forces on May 21, 1969.
