## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Lt. James A. Kirkendall Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of U.S. Route 33 between County Road 191 and Boundry Road, in Auglaize County
Other Information	Lt. Kirkendall was a WWII veteran who served with the Ohio State Highway Patrol for 21 years. On October 28, 1970, he was killed in an automobile collision on U.S. Route 33 when he lost control of his patrol vehicle due to slick road surfaces.
