DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Deputy Sheriff Daniel Kin Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 53 between Township Road 11 to County Road 5, in Wyandot County
Other Information	During his career in law enforcement, Deputy Sheriff Daniel Kin served at the Carey Police Department, the Seneca County Sheriff's Office, and the Wyandot County Sheriff's Office. While serving as a Deputy Sheriff in Wyandot County, Deputy Sherriff Kin's vehicle was struck by a pickup truck while he was transporting a prisoner. He died on December 15, 2022, from his injuries.
