The bill is expected to have a minimal fiscal effect on the state and local subdivisions. The bill generally removes current law provisions concerning the operations of the municipal and county courts and courts of common pleas which duplicate provisions of the Ohio Supreme Court's Rules of Superintendence and Rules of Civil Procedure in favor of those rules. As local courts are required to follow the rules set by the Ohio Supreme Court under current and continuing law, there may be minimal administrative costs to statewide courts, including the Ohio Supreme Court, to update documentation and publications.
