DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"John E. Gallagher Way" ¹
Highway	The northeast-bound and southwest-bound lanes of State Route 10, between W. 47 th Street and W. 50 th Street, in the municipal corporation of Cleveland, in Cuyahoga County
Other Information	John E. Gallagher was a WWII U.S. Army veteran and the founder and chairman of Arrow, International, Inc., a manufacturer of charitable and social gaming solutions. He died at home, surrounded by his family, on August 4, 2021.
