## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"John E. Gallagher Way" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The northeast-bound and southwest-bound lanes of State Route 10, between W. 47 <sup>th</sup> Street and W. 50 <sup>th</sup> Street, in the municipal corporation of Cleveland, in Cuyahoga County
Other Information	John E. Gallagher was a WWII U.S. Army veteran and the founder and chairman of Arrow, International, Inc., a manufacturer of charitable and social gaming solutions. He died at home, surrounded by his family, on August 4, 2021.
