SUMMARY

 Lowers the age, from 66 to 65, at which an Ohio resident may obtain certain discounted senior hunting or fishing licenses or permits.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Senior hunting and fishing licenses and permits

The act lowers the age, from 66 to 65, at which an Ohio resident may obtain any of the following discounted senior hunting or fishing licenses or permits:

- 1. Hunting or fishing license (\$9.00);¹
- 2. Deer permit or wild turkey permit (\$11.00);²
- 3. Fur taker permit (\$7.00);³
- 4. Three-year hunting or fishing license (\$26.00);
- 5. Five-year hunting or fishing license (\$43.34); or
- 6. Lifetime hunting or fishing license (\$81.00).⁴
