DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Litten Brothers Memorial Highway" 1
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route (S.R.) 149 between S.R. 331 and United States Route 40, in Belmont County
Other Information	The Litten brothers, John, Robert David, Jerry, Kenneth, Larry, Carl Steven, and Arthur, served a combined 137 years in the United States Air Force. Their service is honored with signs in the village of Flushing, Ohio and a bench at the Wright-Patterson Air Force Base.
