### DETAILED ANALYSIS

<b>License Plate</b>	<b>DoltForJack</b> license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by the representatives of the Jack Quehl Foundation and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. <sup>1</sup>
<b>Recipients</b>	Available to all applicants.
<b>Eligible Vehicles</b>	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.
<b>Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution</b>	<p>\$20 required contribution.</p> <p>\$10 additional administrative BMV fee.</p> <p>Contributions must be paid to the Jack Quehl Foundation. The Foundation must use the contributions to support the activities of the Foundation.<sup>2</sup></p>
<b>Requirements for Issuance</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Submission of an application;</li><li>2. Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and</li><li>3. Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.</li></ol>
<b>Combined with Special Reserved License Plate</b>	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
