BILL SUMMARY

• Designates the second week of September as "Krabbe Disease Awareness Week."

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Krabbe Disease Awareness Week

The bill designates the second week of September as "Krabbe Disease Awareness Week."¹ Krabbe disease is an inherited disorder that destroys the protective coating of nerve cells in the brain and throughout the nervous system.² It affects about 1 in 100,000 people in the United States. Symptoms of the disease (which generally develop before six months of age) include seizures and the progressive loss of sight, hearing, and the ability to breathe.
