H.B. 416 136th General Assembly **Bill Analysis**

DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Police Officer Phillip Wagner Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of United States Route six between State Route (S.R.) 58 and S.R. 57, within the municipal corporation of Lorain, in Lorain County
Other Information	Officer Wagner was a United States Marine Corps veteran and an officer with the Lorain Police Department. On July 23, 2025, he and another officer were ambushed while eating lunch in their patrol car. Despite receiving medical treatment for multiple gunshot wounds, Officer Wagner died the next day.
