DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Navy Seaman Jadwisiak Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route 163, between Lightner Road and Hartshorn Road, in Ottawa County
Other Information	Stanley J. Jadwisiak was a seaman in the United States Navy during World War II. He died when his ship, the aircraft carrier U.S.S. <i>Wasp</i> , was torpedoed by an Imperial Japanese Navy submarine and sank near the island of Guadalcanal in 1942.
