DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"CPL Lindsey William Mitchell Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The eastbound lanes of Interstate 70 between Brice Road and State Route 256 in Franklin County and Fairfield County.
Other Information	Corporal Lindsey William Mitchell served in the United States Army during the Korean War. On October 29, 1951, he was killed in action fighting communist forces. In addition to many other commendations, he was awarded the Purple Heart.
