## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Auxiliary Patrolman Earl Ulmer Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of Interstate Route 77 between Cambridge Road and the southernmost intersection of that route and Highland Ridge Road, in Washington County
Other Information	Auxiliary Patrolman Ulmer served with the Ohio State Highway Patrol. On July 12, 1953, he was struck and killed by a vehicle while assisting at the scene of a car crash.
