Emergency levy name and purpose	
Changes the purpose of a school district emergency levy from providing for the district's emergency requirements or avoiding an operating deficit to paying the district's current expenses.	No provision.
Disallows the renewal of current emergency levies.	No provision.
Renames emergency levies as "fixed-sum levies" in ballot language.	No provision.
(R.C. 323.32, 5705.192, 5705.194, 5705.197, 5709.92, and 5748.09; Section 3(C).)	
Substitute levies	
Disallows school districts from submitting new substitute levies to voters for approval (R.C. 5705.199).	No provision.

Previous Version (As Introduced, as amended by AM_136_0548)	Latest Version (I_136_0919-2)
Inside millage shifting clarification	
Prohibits a school board from shifting the purpose of its inside millage to increase its overall property tax collections due to the operation of a millage floor (R.C. 5705.314; Section 3(B)).	No provision.
