## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"CPL David James Amheiser Memorial Highway" 1
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route 421 between United States Route 42 and Lodi Road, in Medina County
Other Information	CPL David James Amheiser served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War. He was killed in action by communist forces on August 29, 1970.
