## **Highlights**

The bill prohibits the payment of state Medicaid funds to specified abortion providers.

## **Detailed Analysis**

The bill prohibits the payment of state Medicaid funds to the types of abortion providing organizations specified in federal H.R. 1, the "One Big Beautiful Bill Act." Under this existing federal law, the payment of federal funds is prohibited for one year to any nonprofit organization that meets certain size and funding qualifications and provides abortions in cases where life of the mother is not in danger and pregnancy is not the result of rape or incest.

Medicaid funding consists of both state and federal funds. It is unclear at present to what extent any qualifying organizations may or may not continue to receive state funding. If any organizations were continuing to receive state funding, H.B. 410 would clarify that state-share-only funding of these organizations would not be permitted.
