This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

| Notification of license expiration | |
| Requires the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to send a notice to the holder of a driver's license at least 14 days prior to the expiration date of the license, instead of within 45 days after the expiration date as in current law (R.C. 4507.09(A)(3)). | Allows the Registrar to send an electronic notification to the holder of a driver's license or identification card at least 15 days prior to the expiration date of the license or identification card, if the Registrar's records contain the person's last known electronic mail address or telephone number. Allows the Registrar to send an electronic notification no later than 14 days after the driver's license or identification card's expiration date, if the license or identification card is not renewed. Requires the Registrar to notify, by regular mail, the holder of a driver's license or identification card that has expired within 60 days after the expiration date (R.C. 4507.09(A)(3)). |

| No provision. | Requires the Registrar to include on a mailed vehicle registration renewal notice a general reminder that the applicant check the applicant's driver's license or identification card for its expiration date (R.C. 4503.10(A)(9)). |
