The bill requires the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD) to create a model supported decision-making plan that may be used by an adult with developmental disabilities (the principal) and one or more of the principal's supporters. Minimal cost to DODD is expected from the creation of this model plan.

The bill requires DODD to create informational materials about supported decision-making plans intended for use by (1) adults with developmental disabilities, (2) their family members, (3) professionals likely to encounter supported decision-making plans, including social, medical, and financial service providers, and (4) the general public. There will be administrative costs associated with preparing this material.
