Reimbursement rates	
Eliminates current law provisions requiring a breast cancer screening to be reimbursed at a rate not exceeding 130% of the Medicare reimbursement rate in Ohio, instead prohibiting the reimbursement rate for a covered benefit from being less than any reimbursement rate previously paid by the same insurer to the same provider for the same service (<i>R.C. 1751.62(D), 3923.52(D), and 3923.53(C)</i>).	Restores current law's reimbursement provisions, but increases the Medicare reimbursement rate cap to 300% from 130% (<i>R.C. 1751.62(D), 3923.52(D), and 3923.53(C)</i>).
Delayed effective date	
No provision.	Delays the bill's provisions for three months after its effective date (<i>Section 5</i>).
