## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"MSGT Norman Michael Kilbarger Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The northeastbound and southwestbound lanes of Chillicothe Lancaster Road between Amanda Clearport Road southwest and U.S. Route 22, in Fairfield County.
Other Information	MSGT Norman Michael Kilbarger was a World War II and Korean and Vietnam War veteran who served in the U.S. Army for 21 years. He was awarded the Silver Star for his actions on February 13, 1951. He was also awarded a Bronze Star. He died on July 16, 2005.
