DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Bill Powell Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of U.S. Route 30 between Evening Star Avenue and Neimans Avenue, in Stark County
Other Information	Bill Powell was a World War II veteran who served in the U.S. Army Air Corps. After his service, he built the Clearview Golf Club, which is located in East Canton, Ohio, and is the first golf course in the United States designed, built, and owned by an African American. Mr. Powell died in 2009 on New Year's Eve.
