DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"83 rd Ohio Division Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route (S.R.) 5 between S.R. 59 and Interstate 80, in Portage County and Trumbull County
Other Information	The 83 rd Ohio Division, also known as the "Thunderbolt" Division, was a U.S. Army infantry division that was created in 1917. The Division served in World War I and II, notably participating in the Normandy Campaign and the Battle of the Bulge during World War II.
