DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"George Walker Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of Interstate Route 71 in Columbus between East Fifth Avenue and Cooke Road
Other Information	George Walker served as an officer in the United States Army for four years. After his service, Mr. Walker advocated for his community through his participation with various organizations, including the South Linden Area Commission, Linden-McKinley STEM Academy, Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Greater Linden Advisory Council, and the Community Block Watch Alliance. He died on March 28, 2025.
