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DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Patrolman Earl W. Casterline Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	A portion of East Kemper Road, between Tri County Parkway and Lebanon Road, in Hamilton County
Other Information	Patrolman Casterline served with the Ohio State Highway Patrol. He was killed on October 19, 1943, when his patrol car was struck by a train at a railroad crossing on Kemper Road in Hamilton County.
