DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"PFC Thomas 'Tommy' Pizzino Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of U.S. Route 22 between the eastern border of Harrison County and the intersection of State Route 151, in Harrison County
Other Information	PFC Thomas "Tommy" Pizzino enlisted in the U.S. Army in January of 1965. In November of that year, he was deployed to South Vietnam. PFC Pizzino was killed in action by communist forces in the battle of la Drang on November 17, 1965. As a result of his bravery in combat, he was posthumously awarded the Purple Heart and the Bronze Star Medal for Valor.
