## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Deputy Larry Henderson Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	A portion of I- 275, between mile marker 68.5 and mile marker 69.5, within Hamilton County
Other Information	Deputy Larry Henderson was a United States Marine Corps veteran and served with Hamilton County Sheriff's Office for 33 years. On May 2, 2025, Deputy Henderson was killed by an offender who used his vehicle to intentionally run over Deputy Henderson.
