SUMMARY

 Increases the appropriation for the Campus Student Safety Grant Program by \$10 million in each of FY 2026 and FY 2027.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Campus Student Safety Grant Program

The bill increases the appropriation for the Campus Student Safety Grant Program by \$10 million in each of FY 2026 and FY 2027. H.B. 96 of the 136th General Assembly, the main operating act for the biennium, previously appropriated \$1 million for the program in each of those fiscal years.¹

Under the Campus Student Safety Grant Program, the Chancellor of Higher Education awards grants to institutions of higher education to enhance security measures and increase student safety, with priority given to institutions that demonstrate increased threats of violent crime, terror attacks, hate crimes, or harassment toward students and institutionally sanctioned student organizations.²
